- 11. Set a preliminary Meeting Schedule to address vital topics the Council needs to monitor over the next year: Amy Ming Tasi elaborated on the school bus transportation contact. Currently, there are conversations on how to work with unions and how to make it safe for their emoplyees clients: students, bus para and bus nurses. It's very complicated at this moment, since buses have not been running and a lot of bus companies had to furlough and temporarily suspend money access as going back and forth. There are some a large chunk of employees will have to be recertified and trained. Once these contracts are in place and even if it is not in place, they will still have to be recertified and try it again. It's a very complex issue, even though we have contracts by August, maybe few of the bus companies that will be operational will not certify that will have enough bus attendance, drivers or maintain the buses.

Mr. Spencer will attend a compacity meeting at his daughter school and will bring back the information he gathered to the council.

- 12. **Health & Safety:** Grisel Cardona meantion her issue with health and safety stems from those who are asymptomatic the Mayor and Chancellor said health and safety bills come first. Most adults are asymptomatic they have no fever, nothing, and are you doing temperature checks at the door. Are we asking the district or the DOE to provide proof they were tested? Mr. Spencer spoke to the Superintendent and asked who will address the social support for the district and he was informed Ray Velez will. Mr. Spencer wants the health department involved with testing and support. Ms. Cardona also brought up bus companies' preparation and compliance with the new social distancing. This can be discussed during the joint forum with CCSE.
- 13. **Curriculum & Transition:** Grisel Cardona informed the council she wants the council to meet with D75 or LaShawn Robinson to discuss in depth healing censored, culturally responsive education to address the associate emotional support because students don't understand as to why the schools closed. Once addressed students can get back on track with their academics. The discussion with the district will provide us with insight into what they're planning to address social emotional supports. We also need to receive information on Transition. Mr. Lawerence asked Ms. Groover will schedule a meeting on transisiton. Ms. Cardona asked to add to the calendar meeting agenda on the 22nd talk about the models presented during Chancellor meeting. That can be presented by the Superintendents during his Report.
